## Community Benefit Sharing Project -Phase 2

The Community Benefit Sharing Project -Phase 2 (CBSPII) is a World Bank funded project under the Ministry of Mines, Energy and Rural Electrification (MMERE), through the IDA Grant Facility. The CBSPII also plays a subsidiary role alongside the Tina River Hydropower Development Project (TRHDP) with the objective to enable target communities in the Tina catchment area to benefit from improved access to and use of basic infrastructure and services and to operationalize the community benefit share fund (CBSF) which was created under CBSP-Phase 1.

The CBSPII has four components:

- 1. Component 1 Operationalize the CBSF
- 2. Component 2 Community infrastructure investments
- 3. Component 3 Capacity building training and skills enhancement
- 4. Component 4 Project management support, monitoring and evaluation
