

Fuel Handling Supervisor:

Fuel Handling Supervisor will responsible for the supply and demand, storage, refueling and safety management of various fuels (such as diesel, gasoline, gas, etc.) used in construction sites and mid-term factories. It monitors fuel consumption to increase the efficiency of equipment operation and to prevent fire and environmental pollution accidents.

Qualifications:

- Education: Holder of dangerous goods management certificate (skilled engineer, industrial engineer).
- Experience: Experience in oil management at construction sites, mid-term repair stations, or plant sites.
- Technical Skills: Knowledge of safety rules for handling dangerous goods and operation of firefighting facilities.
- Skills: Good organizational and time management skills, with the ability to handle daily tasks accurately.
- License: Must possess a valid Vehicle Driving License (driving the mobile tank storage).
- Communication: Clear verbal and written communication skills (English proficiency required).

Responsibilities:

1. Fuel supply, demand and, inventory management

- Purchase and import: Estimate the amount of fuel required according to the project schedule and apply for purchase and import supervision in a timely manner.
- Stock identification: Check and data the remaining fuel capacity every day to ensure no disruption to the operation of the equipment.
- Quality inspection: Prevent equipment failure by checking the quality of fuel brought in (whether moisture is mixed, etc.).

2. Safety and Hazardous Materials Management

- Compliance with laws and regulations: Storage management and legal inspection in accordance with relevant laws such as the Dangerous Goods Safety Management Act.
- Inspection of facilities: Regular inspection of oil storage tanks, gas pumps, and piping facilities for aging and leakage.
- Fire Prevention: Remove flammable substances around the storage, equip fire extinguishing facilities, and check operation status.

3. On-site refueling and operation support

- Refueling control: Preparation and distribution control of the refueling record book by each heavy equipment (forklane, dump, generator, etc.).
- Mobile refueling vehicle management: Safety operation and compliance supervision of on-site refueling vehicles.

4. Environmental and administrative management

- Anti-pollution: Establishment of emergency response scenarios and management of control tools (such as absorbent cloth) in case of fuel spills.
- Data report: Completion of fuel consumption analysis report by equipment/construction type and cooperation in the settlement of fuel cost.
